TOUGH ON WEEDS...

ARSENAL is a broad spectrum, versatile postemergent herbicide that controls undesirable vegetation on industrial sites, railroad ballasts, utility substations, plant sites, oil and gas installations and other non-crop sites where vegetation must be controlled for productivity and safety reasons.

A single application of ARSENAL works through both plant foliage and root uptake to give effective control of

a broad spectrum of annual and perennial broadleaf and grass weeds, along with a number of troublesome brush species. Tough to control weeds like Wild Carrot, Canada Thistle and Dandelion are controlled through both contact and residual action,. The short term residual activity of ARSENAL provides season-long control of over fifty weeds and brush species.



EASY TO USE ...

ARSENAL herbicide can be applied at 3 L/ha (1.2 L/ac) with all types of spray equipment, whenever vegetation is actively growing. Rain isn't needed for activation and rain two hours after application won't affect product performance, because ARSENAL is rapidly absorbed through treated foliage. There is no critical temperature range for application as long as plants are growing. Once applied to foliage, ARSENAL moves throughout the plant, accumulating in the growing points where it destroys the ability to

make certain amino acids required for growth and survival. Without these amino acids, plant growth stops within several days and complete death of the plant take place within several weeks. The amino acids affected by ARSENAL are not found in humans or animals. In addition to the post emergence activity of ARSENAL, weeds which emerge after application will also be controlled through root uptake providing season-long control.



EASY ON THE ENVIRONMENT...

When used as directed, ARSENAL presents minimized risk to birds, fish, animals, or insects. Chemical burden on the environment can be reduced with the use of ARSENAL herbicide due to the low application rate and reduced need for follow up treatment, Because ARSENAL binds tightly to soil particles, it stays in place on the treated area. Plants growing outside the ARSENAL treated area are left unaffected and unharmed. ARSENAL is completely bio-degradable, non-volatile and creates no fire hazard.
