How does Telar® work?

Telar® inhibits the growth of susceptible plants by blocking cell division. After application, weeds stop growing, become reddish-purple in colour and the leaves turn yellow. The plants' growing points or buds are usually the first to show symptoms, followed by the death of the entire plant. Initial discolouration may not be seen until 2 to 3 weeks after application.

Tank-Mixes

Telar® plus Krovar®

Apply 120 grams/ha of Telar® with Krovar® I at 6.75 kg/ha to 9.0 kg/ha when weeds are small. A recommended surfactant may be added at 0.1% v/v spray solution to improve activity on emerged vegetation.

Soil-active herbicide programs for total vegetation control

Telar® may be applied sequentially with products registered for non-selective control of weeds on non-crop areas, such as Hyvar®, Karmex®, Krovar®, Princep® or Velpar®. Apply Telar® tank-mixed with 2,4-D Amine or 2,4-D Ester, post-emergence when weeds are small (less than 10 cm tall). Addition of a recommended surfactant at 1L/1000 L spray solution may improve control of weeds growing under adverse conditions.
