### **Product**

Tordon\* 22K is a herbicide for industrial situations (i.e. utility right of way, railways, roadsides and pipelines) and for native range and permanent grass pasture, Tordon\* 22K is the best product to control deep-rooted perennials and hard to control noxious weeds. This is the professional vegetation manager's choice for controlling unwanted deep-rooted perennial weeds in range and pastureland and along industrial rights of way.

Generally Tordon\* 22K is used to control vegetation in Western Canada for safety reasons. For example: controlling vegetation along utility rights of way, railway, roadways and pipelines. Tordon\* 22K is also applied to control noxious weeds which may harm livestock or invade native rangeland or permanent pastures.

- controls the most troublesome perennial weeds species.
- protects land from invasion by noxious weeds
- offers flexible rate programs

### **Product Description**

Tordon\* 22K is a selective herbicide that allows desirable vegetation such as grasses to flourish. As a foliar herbicide Tordon\* 22K must be used when target plants are actively growing.

Tordon\* 22K contains 240 g/L of picloram.

Both foliage and roots of growing plants readily absorb Tordon\* 22K. Factors impacting plant growth also impact herbicide effectiveness. Good growing conditions for the plant coincide with increased weed control once the herbicide has been applied.

Picloram was first registered in Canada in the early 1960s and has a long history of successful use in industrial vegetation management. Picloram was first registered in the United States in 1963. In 1995 it received re-registration from the EPA under today's more vigorous standards.

Tordon\* 22K provides the best control of noxious and deep-rooted weeds. Tordon\* 22K is an important tool to help you manage noxious weeds like leafy spurge, toadflax, field bindweed, knapweed and thistles.

#### **Application Timing**
